Students must be at least 14 & ½ years old at the time of the class to be eligible to participate. (Letters have been mailed home to these students.) Driver's Education requires 30 hours of classroom time, so if your child is absent more than 1 day they will not pass the class. (State law only allows students to miss one class period.) Class days/hours are Monday-Thursday, 8:00am 12:00pm classroom time. The class is limited to 27 students and we accept students from oldest to youngest.
